What: Economic Ecology: An Innovative Approach for Improving the Environment

Economic Ecology maximizes both economic and environmental returns to solve water issues, such as pollutant removal and flood reduction, at a regional scale. It is defined by ecological principles that are validated by engineering measurements and performance standards. It is proactive rather than reactive, addressing the causes of problems and not merely the symptoms. By employing the principles of Economic Ecology, planners and decision-makers can reduce wasteful spending and more effectively meet regulatory requirements for stormwater, flooding, and other elements. Economic Ecology also involves the formation of partnerships with government, public, nonprofit, and private organizations to share costs and increase benefits throughout an entire region or watershed.

Who: Mark Gutshall

Mark Gutshall is the Founder of RiverStewards Benefit Corporation and LandStudies, Inc. He has over 30 years of professional experience in designing, permitting, and constructing ecological restoration projects in the Mid-Atlantic region. His diverse professional background emphasizes land stewardship and community-based planning, which he has applied to numerous projects in watershed planning, open space planning, stream corridor restoration, flood reduction and stormwater management, habitat improvement, and wetland creation. Mark researches and advocates pioneering land management techniques that are functional, cost effective, and environmentally beneficial. He has been a leading voice in the acceptance of "legacy sediments" along stream corridors as a major contributor of sediment and nutrient pollution in waterways throughout Pennsylvania.
