What: The York Plan: York County Contributes to Winning World War II:

The York Plan made national news in World War II - an example of how one community came together to support the war effort. Instead of competing separately for defense contracts, businesses came together to share lists of manpower and machinery to compete for major defense contracts. This presentation - The York Plan: York County Contributes to Winning WWII - will explore how this plan developed and lessons that the York Plan offers for businesses today.

Who: James McClure

James McClure has been editor of the York Daily Record/York Sunday News since 2004 and serves as Atlantic Region editor for the USA Today Network.

Before that, he was East Region Editor for Digital First Media.

He received the Pennsylvania Newspaper Foundation's John Fisher Internet Vision Award, the Pennsylvania NewsMedia Association's Ben Franklin Award for Excellence and the Penn State Graduate School Alumni Society Humanitarian Award.

McClure is the author or co-author of seven books on York County history and has edited many others. He writes regular entries posts in his York County journalism/history blog, York Town Square, and curates the York Daily Record's Retro York website, Facebook group and other YDR digital history projects. He also is a curator of the YDR's Fixing York content project, a Facebook group and other initiatives that seek solutions to community issues.




He holds master's degree in American Studies from Penn State Harrisburg, where his research focused on York County journalism history.

McClure is past president of Pennsylvania Associated Press Managing Editors and past president of the Pennsylvania Society of Newspaper Editors.

ASQ Section 503 Scholarship Announcement

The Harrisburg Section of the American Society for Quality (ASQ) is pleased to announce the launch of an ASQ Section Member benefit scholarship to support members or their immediate families who are enrolled fulltime in college or university science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) programs of study.

To be considered, please return the completed scholarship application included below along with an original essay no later than December 31, 2017. The scholarship will be awarded at the January 2018 section dinner meeting with payment issued to the awardee’s institution for the fall 2018-2019 academic year. Requirements are listed below.

1. Family (spouse, child, or grandchild of section 503 member)
2. Students may qualify by becoming a student member of ASQ.
3. \$1000.00 scholarship
4. Students who will be rising college juniors or seniors after completion of the 2018 spring semester and who are enrolled fulltime in a bachelor’s degree program at a four-year institution of higher learning or a rising sophomore in an associate’s degree program at a two-year school are eligible.
5. Fulltime enrolled in a STEM Program
6. Students who are awarded a scholarship for their junior year are eligible to reapply for their senior year.
7. Scholarship will be Paid directly to the student’s institution by ASQ Section 503
8. Applicant must submit an essay (1,000-1250+ words) discussing “how a graduate in their chosen STEM field of study can impact quality.”
