What: Midterm Elections:

Dr. Madonna will address the Trump factor in the upcoming midterm election, with an emphasis on the historic factor that midterms are essentially a referendum on the president. He will also assess the re-election efforts of Governor Tom Wolf and Senator Bob Casey. Additionally, the fight for control of Congress looms large in the midterm as well as the role Pennsylvania will play in determining which party controls the House of Representatives and the Senate. This year a huge number of women have entered races for seats in state legislatures and Congress, and that is especially true in Pennsylvania. Dr. Madonna looks forward to a lively discussion following his comments.

Who: Dr. Terry Madonna

Dr. Terry Madonna has taught and written about the American presidency and American political parties for more than 30 years. He is the Director of the Center for Politics and Public Affairs, Professor of Public Affairs, and the Director of the Franklin and Marshall College Poll (founded in 1992 as the Keystone Poll). Dr. Madonna served as a Lancaster County Commissioner during the 1970s and has served on numerous governmental boards and commissions over the course of a long career of public service.



He has received numerous awards and honors including a Distinguished Professor award by the PA Department of Education, the President's Medallion at Millersville University, and a special commendation for scholarship and leadership from the Board of Governors of the State System of Higher Education.

As a well-known author and pollster, Dr. Madonna hosts the state's premier politics and public policy interview and commentary show, *Pennsylvania Newsmakers*, on WGAL. He has appeared on CNN's Inside Politics, CBS News, ABC News, C-Span, Fox News, MSNBC, and NBC News, and contributed to political web sites for MSNBC, the Hill Newspaper, Real Clear Politics, Stateline, and Fox News. With his colleague, Dr. Michael Young, he authors a twice monthly column, *Politically Uncorrected*.
