What: Leading Change - What Gets in the Way and How to Get and Stay Unstuck

Change management is often portrayed as a formula – with generic 4 or 5 step processes. The practical reality and challenge, however, is that there really is no “silver bullet” or “how to” manual that can consistently produce the desired results. The dynamics of change are far too great, too varied, and are accelerating too quickly. Strategies for leading change are as diverse as the organizations that should do so – which is every organization—public, private and non-profit. Our speaker will present some perspectives, concepts, and new ways of approaching change leadership and stewardship. The presentation objective is to positively challenge each attendee to consider the unique opportunities for building and maintaining a culture of change that is steeped in learning, collaboration, and practice; and that values innovation in tangible ways.

Keith Chase, a Senior Management Consultant with Gannett Fleming Inc., has had a long, successful managerial and executive leadership career in the public, private, and non-profit sectors. Using his expertise in strategy and leadership development, performance management, and public-private collaboration, Keith has led several hundred planning and strategy projects as both a practitioner and a consultant. He is a highly experienced facilitator and consensus builder. Keith joined Gannett Fleming after 14 years with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania where he held positions as PennDOT’s Deputy Secretary for Aviation, Rail, and Ports; Unit Manger with the Joint Legislative Budget & Finance Committee; Executive Policy Analyst with the Governor’s Policy Office; Transportation Planner with PennDOT’s Office of Planning; and as a Pennsylvania Management Intern.
