What: Meeting the AS9100D Requirements for Counterfeit Part Control:

AS9100D includes the requirement “The organization shall plan, implement, and control processes appropriate to the organization and the product, for the prevention of counterfeit or suspect counterfeit part use and their inclusion in product(s) delivered to the customer.” The counterfeit part plan will be addressed during your risk assessment and the complexity of the plan will be dependent upon the risk to your organization. This presentation will discuss the latest statistics on counterfeit electronic parts and the source of counterfeit parts. In addition to a review of the requirements of AS9100D regarding counterfeit parts, best practices will be presented.

Who: Anne Poncheri, Principal AP Quality Consulting

Ms. Poncheri, provides consulting services for test methods of counterfeit electronic parts for the global electronics industry and the implementation of the Quality Management Standards ISO 9001:2015 and ISO/IEC 17025:2017. She is a certified Exemplar Lead Auditor for ISO 9001:2015 and performs third party audits for two Accreditation Bodies.

Ms. Poncheri has collaborated with ERAI to create InterCEPT (International Counterfeit Electronics Personnel Training). Through the ERAI website, InterCEPT provides web-based training programs designed for the unique needs of the electronics industry. The training is designed to address the counterfeit mitigation requirements of AS9100D and other industry standards. She is a member of the SAE Aerospace G19 Counterfeit Electronic Components Committee whose charter is to address aspects of preventing, detecting, responding to and counteracting the threat of counterfeit electronic components.
