What: Developing Analytics and Decision Support Tools for Environmental/Energy Policymaking and Business

It is often difficult to translate valuable scientific insights and advances into smart public policy or business practice. Regulators and businesses typically lack easy-to-use analytical tools that enable them to understand and implement the latest scientific developments.

The Center for Environment, Energy, and Economy (E3) at Harrisburg University of Science and Technology focuses on this key science 'translation gap' with a solutions-oriented approach. The Center conducts interdisciplinary research on pressing energy and environmental challenges and develops pragmatic, evidence-based, actionable policy solutions. The Center creates decision support tools and systems for governments and businesses using the University's program strengths in data science, computer science, information systems engineering and management, and biotechnology.

Located at HU's main campus in the center of Pennsylvania's policy-making process, the Center for E3 is an important conduit for developing high-level public policy and business practice solutions to air, water, energy, and environmental issues.

John Quigley is the founding Director of the Center for Environment, Energy & Economy at the Harrisburg University of Science and Technology. He served as Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection under Governor Tom Wolf from January 2015 until May 2016; and of the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and

Natural Resources from 2009 to 2011 under Governor Ed Rendell. He is the only person ever to serve as Secretary of both agencies. He served as Mayor of the City of Hazleton, Pennsylvania from 1988 to 1995.

Quigley has held various leadership positions in the nonprofit sector, was an opinion columnist for a northeastern Pennsylvania newspaper, held management positions with major manufacturing companies, and consults to NGOs, foundations, governments, and private industry.

Quigley is a graduate of Bloomsburg University (B.A. political economy) and holds a Master of Public Administration degree from Lehigh University. He has done additional graduate work in economics at Lehigh.
