What: Leveraging Scrum and Empiricism: An iterative and incremental approach to learning from experience

In knowledge work, we are often faced with large degrees of uncertainty as we try to tackle complex problems with complex solutions. As humans, we crave certainty in these instances. As such, we try to leverage predictive processes that have us spending long hours trying to predict the desired inputs and expected outputs only to be left wondering, at the end, where did we go wrong.

We inspect and adapt iteratively while making the work well understood by everyone. The result is a desired solution that makes our customers happy.
